Dear Parents / Guardians,

I have attached the General Consent Form which will allow parents / guardians to complete one form to cover the regular activities of our youthwork including some trips. The limits of this consent form are on the next page, which is for you to keep. You will still be informed in writing (either by email or letter) about all trips and activities that are being run for your young person, and leaders will still need to know in advance whether or not they would like to come. We hope that by having already given your consent we will save you time and hassle.

To save you further hassle, we will not re-issue the form this time next year, ***unless you'd like to update the information, for example as your child matures you may be happier for other details to be known such as email address, mobile phone numbers etc.*** However, it is vital that our records are kept up to date for your child's welfare, ***so we would ask for you to inform us of any changes immediately*** (such as a change of address). All trips are approved by the Youth Work Management Team on behalf of the Parish Church Council and as a Parent/Guardian you will be **notified in writing** (by email or letter) about all trips taking place for your young person's group.

Trips include – Bowling, Ice-Skating, Cinema, going to restaurants or cafes, going to the Pavilions Carol Service, visiting other local churches or the 24-7 Prayer room in Staines, games at local parks and Laser Quest etc.

Trips do not include – Trips to churches which are not local, swimming, residential, community action projects or more adventurous activities such as climbing / abseiling.

Medical Authorisation**

In the event of illness or an accident requiring emergency hospital treatment and / or if I am not contactable, I am willing for this young person to receive any necessary hospital or dental treatment including an anaesthetic and I authorise the youth volunteers approved by the youthwork management team to sign on my behalf any written form of consent required by the hospital authorities, if the delay required to obtain my own signature is considered inadvisable by the doctor or surgeon concerned.

*Please note that this information will be kept in accordance with the data protection act for use only by the Uxbridge Parish and will not be passed on to any third party.

**The medical profession takes the view that a parent's/ guardian's consent to medical treatment cannot be delegated. This view is explicit in the Children Act 1989. Medical consent forms have no legal status and a doctor has the right to insist on parent/ guardian consent in advance or have a leader on hand to sign forms.
